Lands. They are currently assigned to Missionary Care. They visited various ones in Peru and included a three-day visit with us at Morning Star getting better acquainted with the work here and its inherent challenges.



Please pray for Rosalinda who just turned 12, and her sister Ester (14). The family court in charge of their case over in the jungle has been dragging its feet in handing down a final ruling. They seem to only respond to in person visits to move each segment of the case along and that involves several days of travel each time.
